## Brett Favre

It has become comical reading and hearing so-called football experts critical of Brett Favre because he is considering playing football another season. To hear them talk, or see them write, Favre was washed up last year, embarrassed himself, hurt his team and should stay retired.

But the truth of the matter about last year is easy to sum up. He went from Green Bay to the New York Jets. Green Bay had gone 13-3 his final year there and could have played in the Super Bowl. The Jets went 4-12 that same year and couldn't beat Little Sisters of the Poor.

The next year (last year), Favre led the Jets to a 9-7 record and barely missed the playoffs. The team he left, with virtually the same players and the same head coach but a different QB, went 6-10 the season after Favre had taken them 13-3.

Knowledgable football fans would conclude that Favre was good for the Jets. His team was the first to defeat the Tennessee Titans in 2008 - in Week 12.

The Denver Broncos lost their final 3 games and backed out of the playoffs. No one has suggested that Jay Cutler should hang 'em up - that he's washed up. The defending Super Bowl champs, the New York Giants finished at 12-4 but were 2-3 in the last five games. Should Eli Manning call it a day?

## USC basketball coach and Stoneridge Prep

USC head basketball coach Tim Floyd recently resigned amid accusations of NCAA violations. Like the University of Wyoming, Floyd used products of the infamous basketball factory, Stoneridge Prep, to build a powerful USC team.

Players from Stoneridge typically play five or six years of what should be considered high school basketball and they enter college at 20 years of age or even older, as freshmen. Wyoming will have at least four alumni of Stoneridge on their 2009-2010 roster this fall. Another player went to a Mississippi basketball factory.

These players often try to hide their connection to a basketball factory. A star on the USC team, Taj Gibson, played at Stoneridge for two years, then went to a parochial high school for another year. At the parochial high school in San Francisco, he went there long enough to play in a tournament - no regular season. He entered USC as a 22 year-old freshman in '07. He started high school in Brooklyn.

The USC roster for the upcoming year shows two other players with Stoneridge roots (they don't show Gibson having come from Stoneridge but from his city of birth, Brooklyn). Nikola Vučević is a 6'10" freshman from Montenegro, by way of Stoneridge. Mamadou Diarra is a 7'0" freshman from Mali, by way of Stoneridge. He will be 23 in August. Taj Gibson is a 6'9" junior.

Tim Floyd was forced out at USC because he cheated. When you recruit 22 and 23 year old freshmen, that is also cheating, in my opinion. Floyd did it. Schroyer does it at the University of Wyoming.
