THIS MATTER having come before the court upon the Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Judgment on the Pleadings as to Their Sixth Claim for Relief and upon the Motion for Partial Summary Judgment of Defendant Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America pursuant to notice on the 20th day of July, 2010, and the court having considered the pleadings and other matters of record herein, having considered the arguments of counsel and, otherwise being fully advised in the premises, having issued its Decision Letter, dated September 2, 2010, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion for Partial Summary Judgment of Defendant Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America shall be and hereby is granted. The bonds limit Travelers' liability to the face amount of each bond for the period to which the bond applies based upon the express language contained in the bonds. The total potential liability of Travelers for all claims arising in any one bond period under any one bond, if any, shall be limited to the face amount of the bond

regardless of the number of claims that may actually be submitted against any such bond.

2. Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Judgment on the Pleadings as to Their Sixth Claim for Relief is hereby denied for the reasons stated in the attached Decision Letter.


