## From Fries to Fuel Waste to energy

Here we go again.

Another outfit without office space, letterhead or business cards has arrived to solve an ongoing dilemma for the mayor. What to do with the City's "waste." Asking what to do about the City's "waist" would be a cheap shot so I won't go there.

This start-up "company," like two before them, presented a Proposal to the easily-duped Airmen at City Hall. This one is called "TEKGAR, LLC," but who could forget Renewable Utility Development Corporation and Green Power, Inc.?

Green Power's CEO, Michael Spitzauer, must have been on work release under the Huber Law when he traveled to Cheyenne's transfer station and sucked in our irresponsible officials. "Watch this, I will turn your bags of household trash into maple syrup." Right.

So this new outfit, TEKGAR, LLC, typed up a Proposal on their PC, probably in someone's bedroom, then took the four page document (three page Proposal and a cover page) down to Kinko's to be spiral bound. The date on this current three page version of the Magna Carta is February 8, 2007.

The Proposal seeks a "formal Development Agreement between the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming and TekGar, LLC."

*There is no TekGar, LLC registered with the Corporations Division of the Wyoming Secretary of State's office and a Google search brings up nothing in another state.*

It doesn't seem this Proposal gets off to a very good start. In the introductory paragraph, TekGar, LLC states: "Each year the City of Cheyenne handles approximately 100,000 tons of MSW and 400,000 gallons of brown and yellow grease, and has the potential to bring in an additional 36,500 tons of MSW from neighboring cities." MSW is municipal solid waste.

Don't know about the grease but the City of Cheyenne delivers about 300 tons of MSW **PER DAY** to the existing landfill and needed 500 tons per day for the Spitzauer scheme. Green Power, Inc., using the same technology, was to produce 360,000 gallons of diesel **PER WEEK** from the 500 tons of trash a day.

How much diesel could come from 400,000 gallons of grease? Surely not more than 400,000 gallons, could it?

In summary, the Proposal Stage 1 is to set up a "system" to convert grease to diesel. That would be done by the transfer station. The grease will be "handled" at no charge to the City, ostensibly saving the City \$80,000 a year. If Stage 2 does not come to pass, TekGar could continue to process the grease for a period of "not less than 10 years." The City can buy the diesel produced for \$1.50 a gallon.

Stage 2 would require TekGar to process up to 499 tons of MSW per day. What happened to the 100 tons per year? The rest of the Proposal looks like it came from Spitzauer. But with a 50-year lease!

Where do they come from? Where?
